The Taylor Wimpey Pension Scheme - Pensions Research Study

Taylor Wimpey and the Trustees of the Taylor Wimpey Pension Scheme are jointly undertaking a research study across a section of the Pension Scheme membership. This involves writing out to around 3000 of our Scheme members to ask them to participate in this study by providing their health and lifestyle information.

As people are living longer today than they did a generation ago, this means that pensions need to be paid for longer. This study sets out to collate more information about our member's in relation to their health and lifestyle. This information will help us to be more accurate in our assessment of the Scheme's future financial requirements and plan accordingly.


If you have been selected to be part of the study, you will receive a letter from us asking for your participation and giving details how to take part. The study is being undertaken by a specialist medical data company called MorganAsh and commissioned jointly by the Company and Trustees. Participation is entirely voluntary, although we do encourage all those contacted to take part.

If you have not been contacted, don't worry, we have only written to around a 1/3 of our members, as we only require a sample of information, at this stage. The results do not affect any scheme member's benefits, whether you participate or not.
